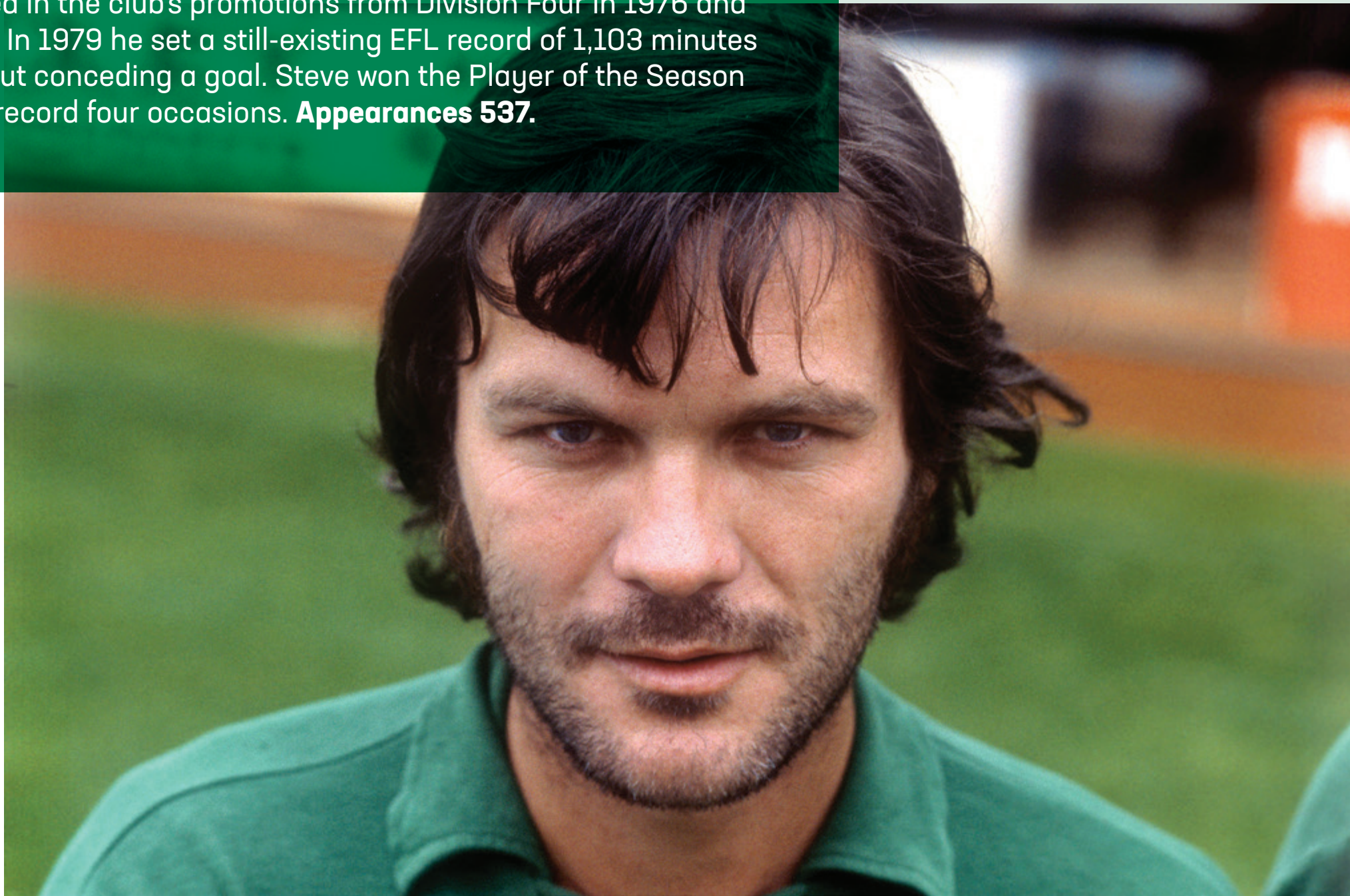


## STEVE DEATH, 1969-82

One of the most recognisable characters of the Reading teams of the 1970s. At just 5'8" he made up for his lack of inches with agility and bravery and was capable of astonishing saves. Steve played in the club's promotions from Division Four in 1976 and 1979. In 1979 he set a still-existing EFL record of 1,103 minutes without conceding a goal. Steve won the Player of the Season on a record four occasions. **Appearances 537.**

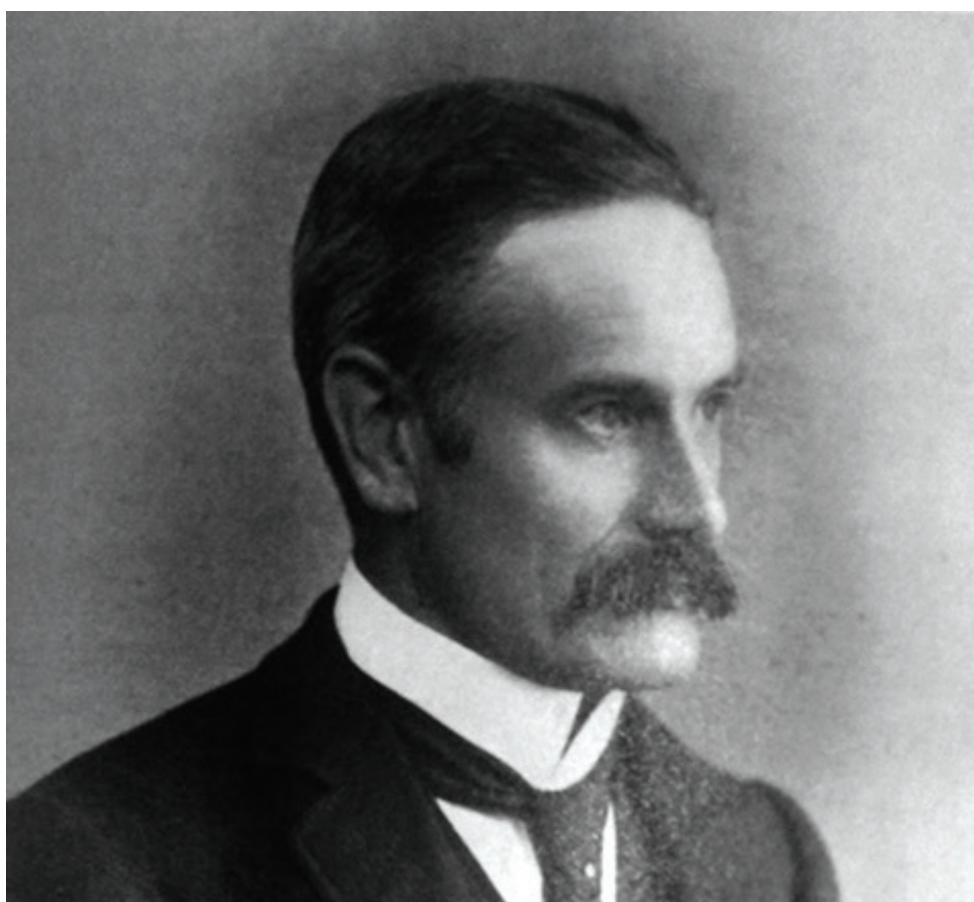


# Great Goalies

Reading have had many great goalies down the years. Here's three Hall of Famers who have all won honours for the club.

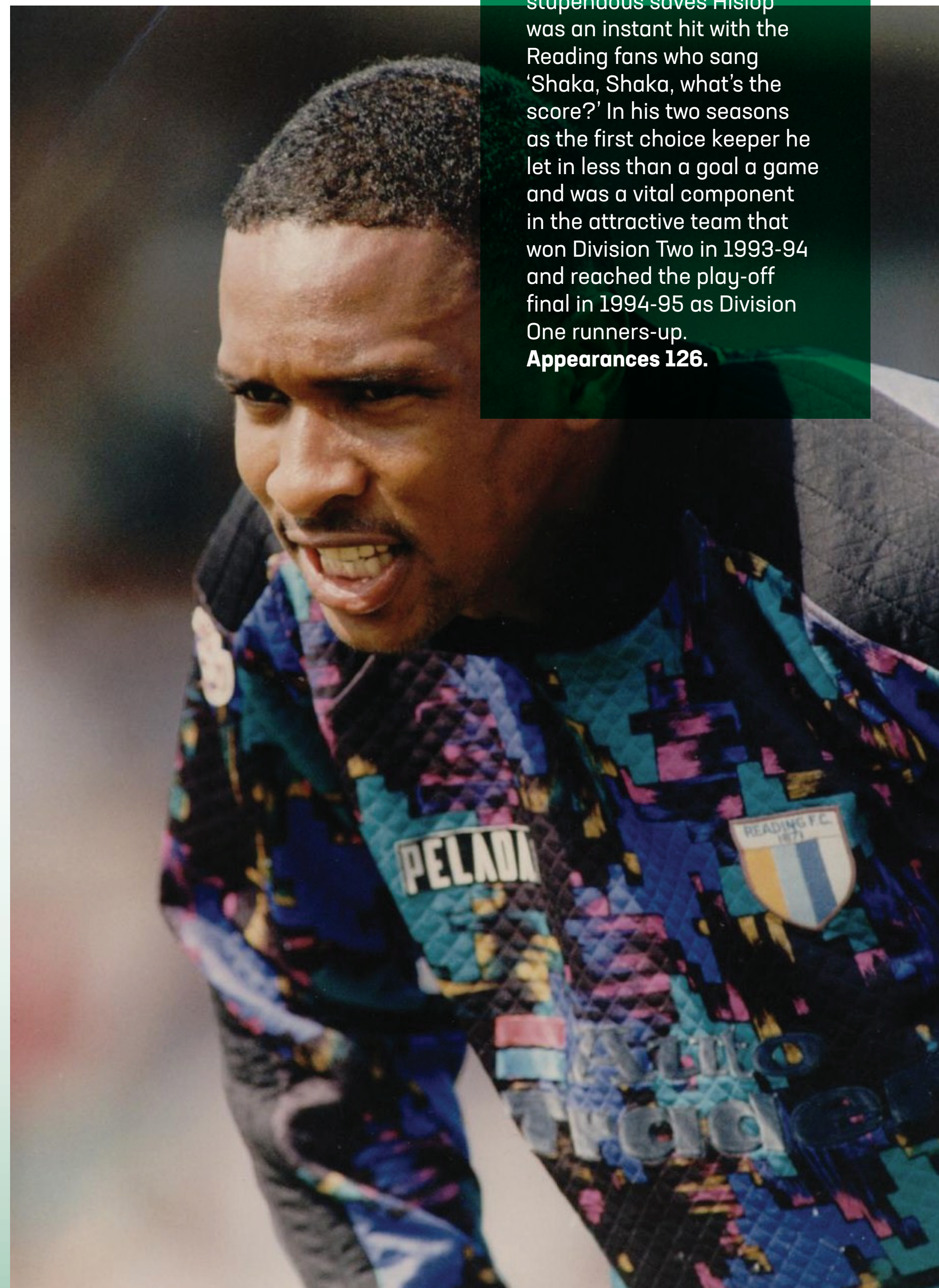
## SHAKA HISLOP, 1992-95

Tall, cool and capable of stupendous saves Hislop was an instant hit with the Reading fans who sang 'Shaka, Shaka, what's the score?' In his two seasons as the first choice keeper he let in less than a goal a game and was a vital component in the attractive team that won Division Two in 1993-94 and reached the play-off final in 1994-95 as Division One runners-up. **Appearances 126.**



## STANLEY HAYWARD, 1875-89

Stanley was in our Berks & Bucks Cup win in 1879, played for the Berks & Bucks FA and was regarded in his prime as a fine goalkeeper worthy of England consideration. He could be quite an attacking goalie, scoring six times from that position including two in a match. With 200 known games Stanley is probably the record appearance maker for the amateur Reading FC and was also Secretary 1883-89. **Appearances 200+, goals c7.**
