Thank you for the opportunity to seek re-election to the STAR Board. Working on the campaign has proven my ability to work with our Chair and bring other organisations with us to galvanise the fanbase, working through technical details and concerns with powerful stakeholders, and delivering meaningful results through moving the owner to a position where the club went from being not up for sale, to for sale, to sold - alongside supporting activity leading to Dai Yongge's suspension.

Outside of my role on the board I bring 22 years of experience working in the Civil Service, with wide ranging experiences including project management, diplomacy, analysis and strategy. I'm an accredited and adaptable project manager, skilled in negotiation and conflict resolution, with a meticulous eye for detail. Having worked in high-pressure crisis response roles, I'm used to solving complex problems swiftly and resourcefully.

My guiding principles are collaboration, openness, and member focus. If re-elected, I intend to:

 Act as a "critical friend" to new ownership, advocating for fan-led improvements in matchday experience, transparency, and community engagement.

- Continue to elevate member feedback and voice, ensuring STAR remains a clear voice to the club.
- Share lessons from Sell Before We Dai nationally, strengthening Trusts across English football and supporting others with issues building off our experience.
